

LEADERSHIP AND COACHING FOR SYSTEMS CHANGE

Objectives

- Learn and practice strategies for leading and coaching both teams and individuals for change in an RtI framework, and supporting the implementation of RtI for academics and behavior.
- Establish coaching as the capstone of a systematic, articulated professional development plan that is aligned with the district's or school's RtI framework.
- Begin to understand the importance of a consistent process to gather and use data for identifying goals, determining next steps, planning, and committing to action to improve systems and results.
- Provide a continuum of leadership and coaching strategies and styles in response to teacher knowledge, skills and needs, stages of change implementation, and levels of team development.
- Identify and assess specific elements of a positive school culture that guarantees learning for all.

District or school teams of principals, district leaders, teacher leaders, instructional coaches, internal and external coaches



This training is designed to help teams to move forward with the implementation of their RtI framework. Class activities include presentation of theory, reading, discussion, group and partner work, modeling and demonstration, reflection, and practice and feedback. Sessions include the opportunity to coach peers, observe peer coaches, receive coaching from peers, and give and receive feedback.

Participants will enroll a coaching client and conduct a minimum of five coaching sessions outside of the class.
